IS MY CHILD A CYBERBULLY?

If you have noticed that your child/student exhibits any of these warning signs, talk to your child/ student about what he/she is doing while online, the consequences of his/her behavior, and appropriate online behavior.

WARNING SIGNS OF BEING A BULLY ONLINE...

- \checkmark Minimizes the computer screen when an adult enters the room.
- \checkmark Gets angry when he/she cannot use the computer.
- \checkmark Laughs a lot while using the computer.
- \checkmark Refuses to talk about what he/she does while on the computer or cell phone.
- \checkmark Has multiple accounts.
- \checkmark Has been a victim of cyberbullying.
- \checkmark Has altered someone else's photo.
- \checkmark Wants to use the computer in private.
- \checkmark Refuses to allow an adult to view his/her messages.
- \checkmark Goes to websites that rate appearance.
